ADMINISTRATION AND STAFF

Ed Blankmeyer is in his 12th season at St. John's. During his time at St. John's, Coach Blankmeyer has been recognized as the Northeast Region Coach of the Year in 2004 and 2005, as well as the BIG EAST Conference Coach of the Year in 1996 and 2005. Blankmeyer's teams won BIG EAST Championship titles in 1997 and 2005 and made appearances in the NCAA Tournament in 1997, 2004 and 2005. His 2005 team reached the finals of the Corvallis, Ore., Regional against an Oregon State team that won the NCAA Championship the following season. During Blankmeyer's coaching tenure, 33 players have signed professional contracts, and he has had the privilege of coaching Major Leaguers Craig Biggio, Mo Vaughn, Matt Morris and recent St. John's first round draft pick Craig Hansen.

Mike Hampton is in his sixth year as an assistant coach at St. John's. Hampton's primary coaching duties are with catchers and hitters, but he also serves as the program's recruiting coordinator and coordinates Red Storm players participation in sanctioned summer leagues. Hampton, a first team All-American at Clemson, was selected in the fourth round of the 1994 Major League Draft. Injuries cut short a promising professional career, after he played four years in the Cincinnati Reds system. Prior to St. John's, he had coaching stints at Clemson and West Virginia.

Scott Brown is entering his fifth season as the St. John's pitching coach. His work with the St. John's pitching staff has yielded tremendous results, as four pitchers from the 2005 staff signed professional contracts and members of the 2006 staff combined to post the fifth-lowest earned run average in the nation (3.21). Brown was an All-American pitcher at Cortland State and coached two years at his alma mater, prior to arriving at St. John's. As Cortland State's pitching coach, the program participated in two NCAA Tournaments.

Julio Vega enters his first season as a volunteer assistant at St. John's. Vega has a wealth of collegiate and professional coaching experience and joins the Red Storm staff after working as head coach of the Plattsburgh Thunder of the New York State Collegiate League from 2002-2006. A former fifth round draft choice of the San Francisco Giants in 1990, Vega has coached in both the collegiate and professional ranks after a six-year professional career.
